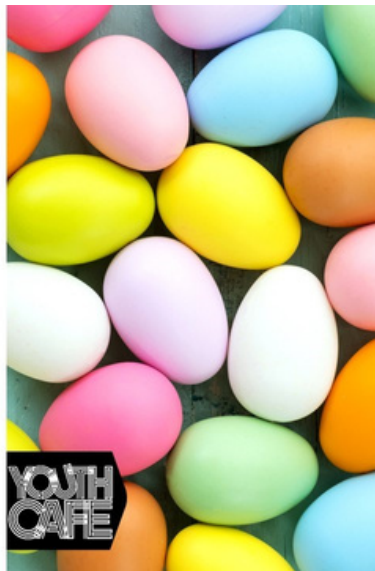
What? Games, faith exploration, pizza, chocolate, and cake!
